

STUDENT GPA

Student GPA is the average of all course grades received at Haworth Public taken during a specific marking period. Term grades are based on a 4.0 scale and given at the end of each 9 week term (also called a quarter or marking period)

***Note - Final course grades are based on all term grades for the course and in some cases, a final exam.

HONOR ROLL

The Haworth Public School Honor Roll recognizes significant student achievement in academics for grades 6, 7 and 8. Honor Roll achievement is based on a student's term grade point average. See table below for GPA requirements.

Term GPA	Honor
3.75 – 4.0	Gold Honors
3.50 – 3.74	Silver Honors
3.25 – 3.49	Bronze Honors

A **term grade point average (GPA)** is calculated based on the *term* grade for each marking period and is used to determine honor roll. Student GPA is calculated by multiplying the course grade by the credit weight (Quality points) and dividing by the total credits attempted for the marking period. (see Example #1) [$GPA = \text{Quality Points} / \text{Total Credits}$]

Example 1: Calculating term GPA's:

$$[GPA = \text{Quality Points} / \text{Total Credits}]$$
