## Classroom Policies:

<u>Class Time:</u> This is a studio art class; therefore all work must be done in the art room. If you do not work on your project during class time, you will need to come to art club to complete the work.

<u>Absence:</u> If you are absent from art for any reason you are responsible to make up the work you missed. Art Club is available to complete projects.

**Late Work:** With the exception of unplanned absences, all work must be turned in on time.

<u>Tardiness/Late to Class:</u> One infraction and you will get a warning. The second infraction you will get a referral to an administrator. If you are late because you were with a teacher or staff member, you must bring a pass in order to be excused.

<u>Gum Chewing</u>:  $1^{st}$  Time and you will get a warning.  $2^{nd}$  infraction you will speak to me at recess.  $3^{rd}$  infraction and you will see an administrator.
