Classroom Policies:

Come to Class Prepared: You will need your charged laptop. Smock is optional, but strongly advised.

Grading: All projects in class count toward your grade, including journal entries, exit tickets, do now's and critiques. See the grading Rubric on the back of this paper.

Class Time: This is a studio art class; therefore all work must be done in the art room. If you do not work on your project during class time, you will need to come to art club to complete the work.

Absence: If you are absent from art for any reason you are responsible to make up the work you missed. Art Club is available to complete projects.

Late Work: With the exception of unplanned absences, all work must be turned in on time.

Tardiness/ Late to Class: One infraction and you will get a warning. 2nd infraction you will get a detention. If you are late because you were with a teacher or staff member, you must bring a pass in order to be excused.

Gum Chewing: 1st Time and you will get a warning. 2nd infraction you will speak to me at recess. 3rd infraction and you will get a detention.

Appropriate Classroom Behavior & School Code of Conduct: The goal of this class is a productive Art Studio environment, where all students follow the Code of Conduct, the posted rules and are congenial in the class, making all students feel welcome.
